FOR 2025

The board of directors and all directors of the Company warrant that there are no false representations or misleading statements contained in, or material omissions from the contents of this announcement, and jointly and severally accept responsibilities for the truthfulness, accuracy and completeness of this announcement.

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

- Aluminum Corporation of China Limited* (the “**Company**”) intends to distribute a cash dividend of RMB0.270 (tax inclusive) for the year 2025, of which a cash dividend of RMB0.123 each share (tax inclusive) was distributed in interim 2025, and a cash dividend of RMB0.147 each share (tax inclusive) is proposed for final period of 2025.
- The Company completed its interim equity distribution for 2025 on 17 October 2025. The final profit distribution for 2025 is based on the total share capital registered on the equity registration date of implementing equity distribution and the specific date will be clarified in the announcement on the implementation of equity distribution. The distribution is expected to be completed on or before 14 August 2026.
- If the total share capital of the Company changes before the equity registration date for the implementation of the 2025 year-end equity distribution, the Company proposes to maintain the distribution amount per share unchanged and adjust the total distribution amount accordingly. Details of adjustments will be published separately.
- The proportion of cash dividends for the year 2025 to the net profit attributable to shareholders of the listed company in the Company’s consolidated financial statements for the year 2025 is 36.55%.
- This profit distribution proposal is subject to the 2025 annual general meeting of the Company for consideration and approval.
- The Company does not trigger any circumstances that might lead to the implementation of additional risk warnings pursuant to Clause 9.8.1(8) of the Rules Governing Listing of Stocks on the Shanghai Stock Exchange.

I. CONTENT OF PROFIT DISTRIBUTION PROPOSAL

After the audit conducted by Ernst & Young Hua Ming LLP and Ernst & Young, the Company recorded a net profit of RMB7,215,737,000 in the financial statements of the parent company for 2025 and the net profit attributable to the shareholders of listed company in the consolidated financial statements amounted to RMB12,673,918,000.

Pursuant to the relevant provisions of the Articles of Association of Aluminum Corporation of China Limited, after the consideration by the board of directors, the Company intended to withdraw the statutory reserve fund of RMB721,574,000 (including RMB389,745,000 previously provisioned for interim 2025) based on the 10% of the net profit of the parent company in the financial statements for 2025 and it intended to distribute cash dividends for the year 2025 to shareholders at RMB0.270 (tax inclusive) per share. After deducting the 2025 interim dividend at RMB0.123 per share (tax inclusive) distributed by the Company, it intended to distribute 2025 final dividend at RMB0.147 per share (tax inclusive) to all shareholders of the Company. Based on the current total issued share capital of the Company of 17,154,971,327 shares, the total final dividend payable for the year 2025 is RMB2,521,780,785.07 (tax inclusive), which together with the total dividend of RMB2,110,142,745.59 (tax inclusive) paid by the Company in the interim period of 2025, would result in a total dividend payout of RMB4,631,923,530.66 (tax inclusive), representing approximately 36.55% of the net profit attributable to the shareholders of the listed company for the year 2025 in the consolidated financial statements of the Company. In 2025, the Company did not implement capital reserve capitalisation.

During the period from the date of disclosure of this announcement to the date of registration of shareholdings for the implementation of the 2025 final equity distribution, should there be any change in the total share capital of the Company, the Company intends to maintain the distribution ratio per share unchanged and adjust the total amount of the distribution accordingly, and will make a separate announcement on the specific adjustments.

This profit distribution proposal is subject to the 2025 annual general meeting of the Company for consideration and approval.

II EXPLANATION ON WHETHER IT TRIGGERS OTHER RISK WARNING SCENARIOS

The Company's cumulative cash dividend payout over the latest three financial years amounts to 91.90% of the average annual net profit for the same period, with a total dividend paid of approximately RMB9.727 billion. These metrics do not trigger any circumstances that might lead to the implementation of additional risk warnings pursuant to Clause 9.8.1(8) of the Rules Governing Listing of Stocks on the Shanghai Stock Exchange, which states: For a company with positive net profit in the latest accounting year and positive undistributed profit at the end of the financial year in the parent company's financial statements, if the cumulative cash dividend payout over the last three financial years is less than 30% of the average annual net profit for the same period, and the cumulative cash dividend payout over the last three financial years is less than RMB50 million, the Company may be subject to other risk warnings. The Resolution in relation to the profit distribution proposal for 2025 has been reviewed and approved by the 5th meeting of the ninth session of the audit committee of the board of directors convened on 26 March 2026, and the 11th meeting of the ninth session of the board of directors convened on 27 March 2026. The profit distribution proposal mainly takes into account the Company’s industry characteristics, internal and external business environment, future development and project investment, as well as the reasonable returns for investors. It aligns with the overall interests of the Company and all its shareholders. The board of directors has agreed to submit this proposal to the Company’s 2025 annual general meeting of the Company for consideration and approval.

IV. DISCLOSURE OF RELEVANT RISKS

The future development of the Company and the long-term interests of shareholders have been comprehensively considered in the profit distribution proposal, which will not have a significant impact on cash flow, production and operation of the Company.

The profit distribution proposal shall be implemented pending the consideration and approval at the 2025 annual general meeting of the Company.
